Dear Parent/Carer,

This letter is to inform you about the provision in place for Year 6 over the next week. We will revert to our remote learning format from earlier in the year, with learning predominantly taking place using our blogging system on Purple Mash. All children should be familiar with this now but if you have any questions, please send your queries to the school office who will forward them on to me.

The SATs assessment papers planned for next week will now take place the following week, the week commencing the 17th May. This gives the children an extra week to revise the key areas of spelling, grammar, reading and maths. Alongside the home learning blog, the revision blog can also be accessed, which includes some recorded videos and practise questions.

Daily check-ins will resume and these will take place via TEAMS at 8.45am and 3pm on school days, starting at 3pm this afternoon. The link is available on the class blog, alongside some activities for this afternoon.

I would also like to run live maths and English sessions next week. English will start straight after the morning check-in session and maths will run from 11am. These sessions will be approximately 45 minutes each in length. All of these sessions can be accessed from the same TEAMS link. I will also be adding recorded lessons and tasks to the blog each day.
