- The Great Wall of China and the Terracotta army




Maths


- Multiplication and division - including 2, 5 and 10 times tables and division facts.



- Statistics - Interpret and construct pictograms, tables, charts, block graphs and diagrams. Ask and answer questions about data.



- Geometry – properties of shape.
- Fractions Recognise - find, name and write fractions $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{2}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{3}{4}$, $\frac{2}{3}$ and know that $\frac{2}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$ are the same.
